Health Care Setting

Keeping Children Safe DVD



The *Keeping Children Safe* DVD is a comprehensive injury prevention tool designed to help educate parents about the most frequent causes and prevention strategies of injury to children birth to five years.

The DVD consists of 26 “vignettes” which demonstrate a “wrong” and “right” way to protect a child from injury. The vignettes are categorized within a cartoon “home”, with danger areas displayed in different rooms in the house, as well as in areas around the home and in cars. Selecting the rooms or areas will give you a list of vignettes to play.

The DVD also has the option to play the video in a continuous loop format. It can be placed in the waiting room or education room. It can also provide the opportunity for a more interactive and targeted education session.

Parents can be given copies of the DVD for home viewing.

The DVD is available in English, Spanish, and Vietnamese.
